With influences such as Jimi Hendrix, Janis Joplin and The Black Crowes, this Arizona based band has an original, down home, rock 'n' roll sound to compliment an energetic live show that will keep you moving and always wanting more.

The Blue Rose Band's debut album "Home" was released in the late summer of 2008. "Home" was engineered and produced by four time Grammy nominee and Double Platinum Award winner, Ralph Patlan (Jamie Foxx, Megadeth, Brian "Head" Welch among others). This album has a guitar driven, swamp boogie flavor with soulful lyrics and an in your face rock "n" roll edge. The combination created a vintage sound with a modern day twist that will make you want to savor it for years to come.
